

The 3rd International Conference on Computing, Electronics, and Electrical Engineering (ICE Cube 2021) was held on October 26-27, 2021 at the BUITEMS Quetta. The two-day conference was focused on the promotion of digitization and technologies and was attended by several notables, researchers, and academicians from all over Pakistan.

The conference was sponsored by the European Union Delegation to Pakistan, Defense Housing Authority, Quetta as the chief partners and technically co-sponsored by the IEEE Karachi section. ICE Cube conference also ensured partnership with the relevant industry stakeholders including MAPLE solar solutions, Pakistan Telecommunication Company Limited, United Nations Development Program, ECO Science Foundation, and Asian Council of Science Editors.

Adapting to the needs of the world, the conference offered physical and virtual participation to the speakers, authors, and attendees. Having participants from over 18 countries, the instigating conference was dedicated to recent research trends alongside sustainable technologies. 



Considering the role of education for




with the serious effects of Covid-19 pandemic and Tree Plantation. One of the groups
