
15th Meeting of BUITEMS Academic Council

These teams presented their ideas before the panel of judges and the audience. They competed with leading universities of Pakistan and qualified for final round and received appreciation from the judges.


Finalists presented their ideas to another panel of judges which included the faculty, alumni, entrepreneurs, investors, and

A two day workshop on "GIS Software" was conducted


on April 15, 2014 at SUPARCO Lab at






