


British Council Social Enterprise Training Reported by: Sadia Khan, Rehmat Khan

petrol, diesel, jet fuel, kerosene and other products are fractionated from crude oil. Also information was disseminated about different grades of Aphalt; various Asphalts used for making roads, airports and motorways.

The students were also familiarized with techniques to remove sulfur from diesel in DHDS unit which may otherwise cause a problem for auto vehicles.
