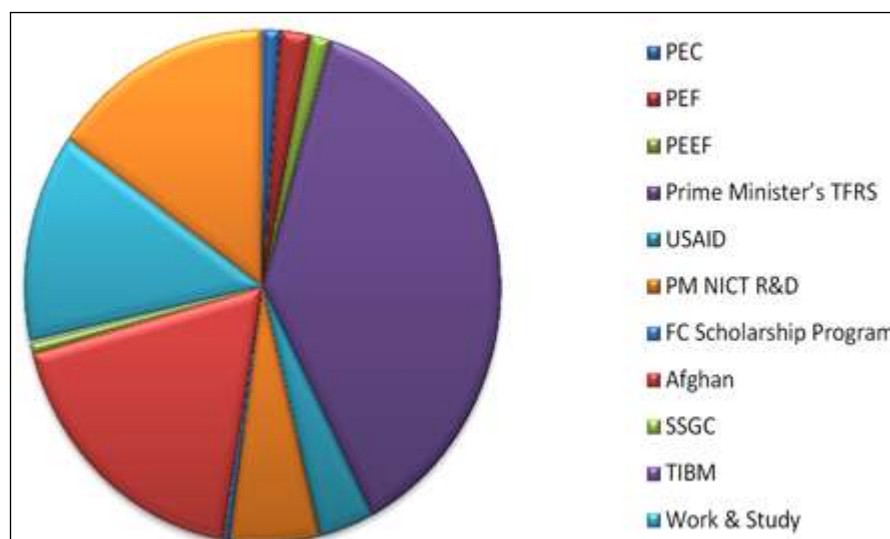
Financial Assistance Office:

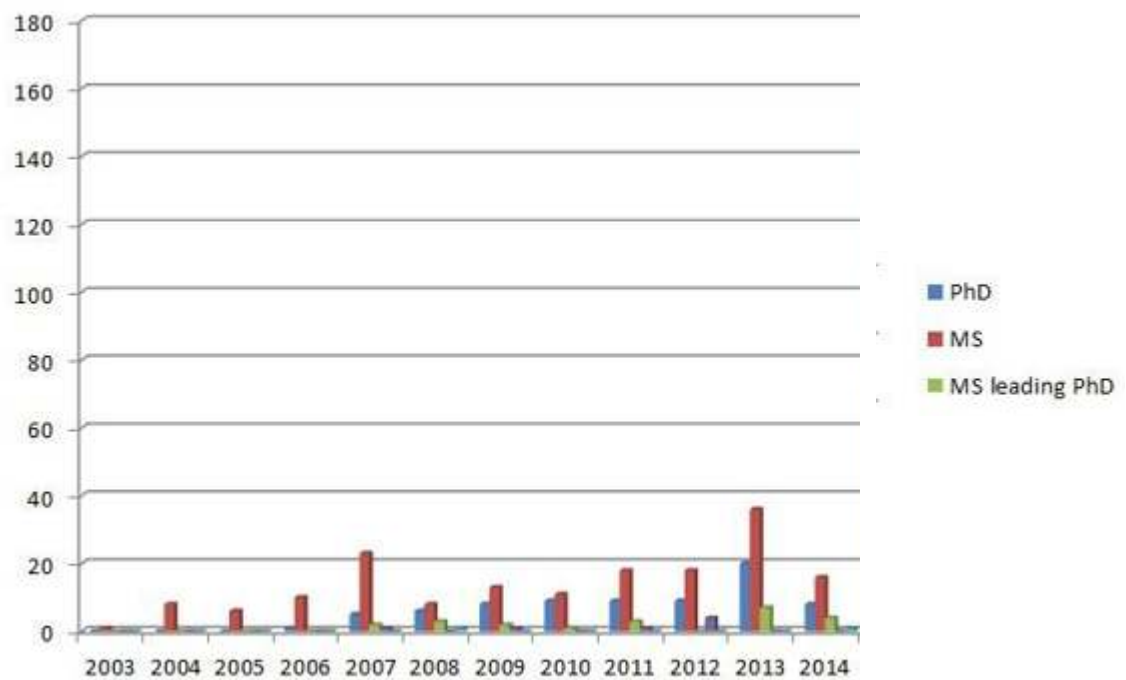
Faculty Development Program

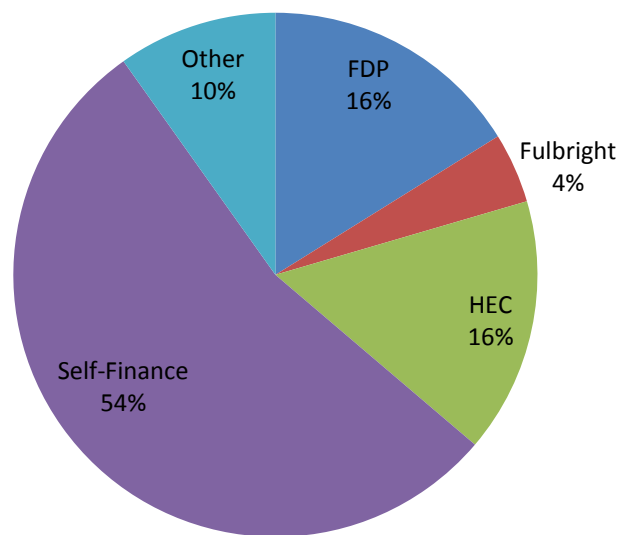
Current Status of Indeginous / Foreign Scholars

Annual Budget estimate for the financial year 2013-14 was approved to the tune of Rs. 824.970 million, which was revised to Rs. 685.209 million owing to less receipts in certain heads of grants. The earning/receipt of the University in the year 2013-14 was Rs.135 million. The major contribution in increased revenue is attributed to efficient financial management and enrollment of new students in newly established departments/programs.

PERN-II Advisory Committee

PERN – II (Pakistan Education & Research Network-II) is a research and education network of Pakistan which was launched in 2002. The purpose was to provide communication infrastructure to the universities, institutions of higher learning and research organizations to meet their networking and internet requirements. The network has evolved significantly and is providing valuable services, like high-speed internet, audio/video conferencing and access to digital library resources. Keeping in view the growing need of the internet services to its expanding faculty usage, BUIITEMS has enhanced the bandwidth from 75 mbps to 100 mbps in year 2014.

Higher Education Commission in the year 2014 constituted “Advisory Committee on PERN Projects” to assist IT division of HEC in improving the performance and productivity of all ongoing activities under the said projects and BUIITEMS Director Information Technology Mr. Muhammad Anwar Khan was nominated as member of this committee. The PERN Advisory Committee also helps HEC in identifying the areas of national priorities for launching new projects through which universities/institutes would be able to overcome the deficiencies which they experience from time to time.



IBM SPSS Training for Researchers through Video link.

A two day IBM SPSS (Statistical Package for the Social Sciences) training was organized by the Directorate of IT in collaboration with Research Center for Training & Development to enhance the statistical skills of faculty members.

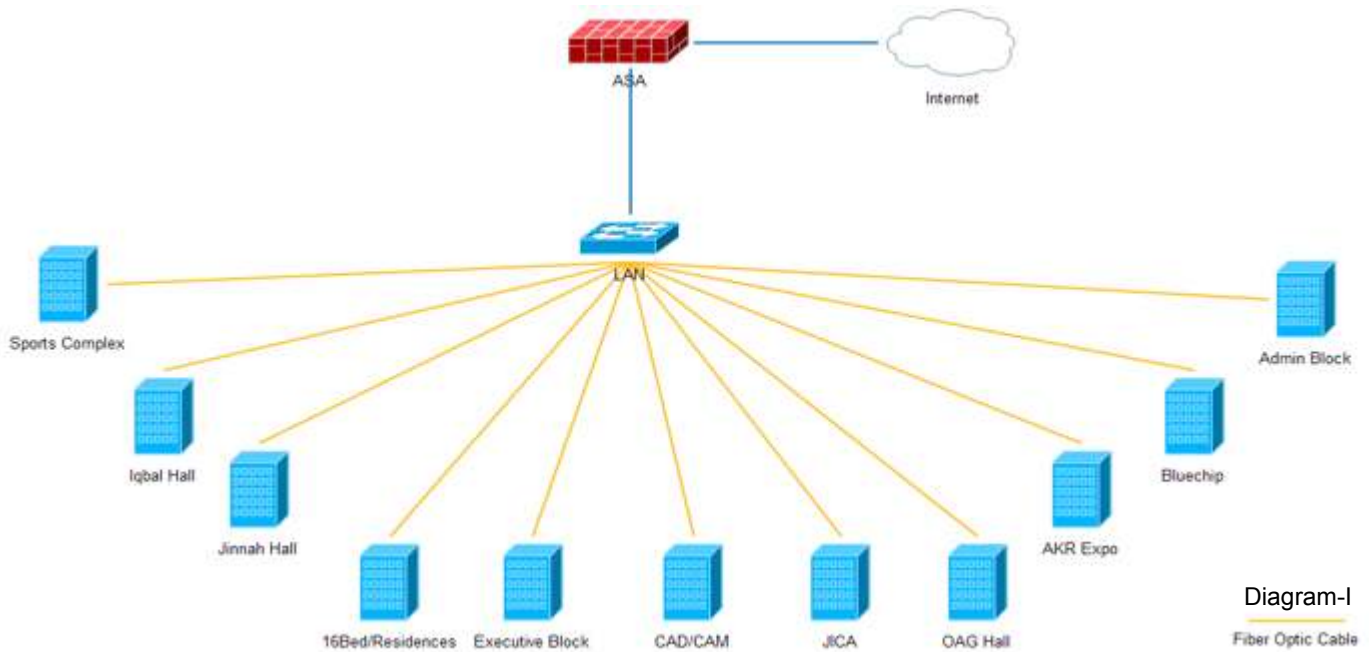
This two day training was held on September 19-20, 2014 in computer labs at Takatu and City Campus simultaneously via video conferencing. Eight participants from each faculty of BUIITEMS attended the training.

Deployment of Fiber Optics facility in Takatu campus

In order to provide uninterrupted network service to students, staff and faculty of BUIITEMS the network infrastructure was upgraded by deploying fiber optic cable between IT Directorate’s Datacenter and Sports Complex, Iqbal Hall, Jinnah Hall, 16-Bed Hostel, Executive Block, CAD/CAM, JICA Hall, OAG Hall, Arfa Karim Randhawa Expo Center, Bluechip Lab, and Admin Block (Diagram-I). This upgradation, helped improve BUIITEMS network infrastructure by saving recurring maintenance costs, reducing frequent network outages, and increasing speed, bandwidth and security of the network.

To further strengthen the security and reliability of the network each site/building has been equipped with a managed switch and an Adaptive Security Appliance. With the renovation of CAD/CAM building, two computer labs with capacity of hosting 70 computers each and 12 offices have been networked and connected to fiber optic backbone. Similarly the new JICA Hall offices and classrooms have been networked and connected to fiber optic backbone.





Technical Support provided by CMS Team during Spring/ Fall 2014 admissions

Campus Management Solution was introduced in 2008 in order to automate the academic life cycle of student wherein various modules like Student Admissions, student records, student financials, Students grades, campus community were implemented. So far the utilization of CMS is almost 93%.

In 2010 the batch spring 2007 was completely gazetted and graduated from CMS, their gazette, official transcripts and degrees were issued through CMS. In order to keep all stake holders abreast of the developments in CMS and to facilitate them in its usage, CMS team arranged technical training sessions round the year. These stakeholders include Instructors, Chairpersons, Focal Persons, Deans, Academic departments, Finance department etc. Details of the trainings imparted last year are as under:

Like previous years, this year too CMS team extended following technical support to Student Affairs and Academic department during admissions of Spring 2014 and Fall 2014 batches.

- Defining eligibility criteria for each program.
- Collection of all applications through Online portal i.e. BOLAS (BUIITEMS Online Admission System)
- Provision of system generated chalan forms along with admission form.
- Submission of applicant's data to NTS.
- Furnishing data of all applicants including NTS result to the academic department for the preparation of merit lists.
- Subsequent provision of technical support to the concerned department for student's matriculation in CMS and generation of fee chalans and their postings through CMS.
- Preparation of reports about student's fee status, academic profile along with their pictures etc.

These trainings not only provided an overview of CMS but also equipped the trainees with the techniques to utilize it in more efficient manner. Apart from conducting training session, CMS team also provides technical assistance on ERP, whenever requested by any department. That includes constant support of faculties and examination of department during the process of grading and result posting and to Finance Department for fee calculation and invoice generation.

Up-gradation of Blue Chip Computer Lab, Takatu campus

Directorate of IT is constantly striving to provide latest and most upgraded information technology tools and services for the facilitation of students and faculty in performing their R&D activities. Taking a step forward, computer lab of BUIITEMS named "Blue-chip lab" was upgraded with state of the art branded computers.

This computer lab was established in 2005, with branded computers Compaq PIV, 512 MB RAM and 40GB HDD – *the latest of the era*.

Now the complete hardware has been upgraded to Dell Optiplex 9020 (Core i5 processor, 4GB RAM and 1 TB HDD). This up gradation will surely help students and faculties while performing practicals through the advanced softwares.



Up-Gradation of Computer Lab

Computer Lab 3 was established in 2002 with Dell Pentium 4 computers. On July 21, 2014. This computer lab was upgraded with 25 Dell OptiPlex 3020 Core i3 3.4 Ghz, 4Gb DDR3 RAM, 500GB SATA, High speed Laser Jet Printer 401 DN(Duplex and Network) and contemporary software like MS Office, SPSS, Stata and Strong anti virus software with the objective of making students well versed in usage of information technology and enhance their computer literacy and research. The Lab has computer work stations with necessary hardware and software and it is regularly and continuously used for work by undergraduate and graduate students of Management Sciences and Economics department.

Extension of Audio Visual Facility at Seminar Hall, City Campus

A new Seminar hall was established in City campus with a seating capacity of 45 participants. This facility is equipped with multimedia and interactive technologies having 20 wireless delegate units, smart board, Dell core i3 desktop, high definition web camera, sound system and high resolution multimedia projector to support audio and video conferencing. This development was another evidence of the vision of Directorate of IT for providing state of the art services to its users. Students and faculty have arranged multiple training sessions, seminars and conferences since its inauguration.

Fixation of SMDs (Surface Mounted Display)

On the eve of 10th convocation of BUIITEMS, two SMD (Surface Mounted Display) screens, each of size 10' x 20' were installed at Arfa Karim Randhawa expo center. These screens not only gave a very pretty look to the whole event but also provided a clear view of the full proceedings to the participants sitting in the last rows of the convocation hall.

BUIEMS Medical Center

BUIEMS is providing medical facilities to its students and all its employees at the medical center. The Medical center provides health facilities to students and employees and their families. The patients visiting the medical center are examined by qualified medical officers and receive required medicines.

The medical team at Takatu Campus consists of three medical officers, two male nurses, a male nursing assistance, a junior clerk and a ward boy. The medical center has two wards and two emergency stations to handle minor emergencies.



Activities:

The medical center Takatu Campus was inaugurated on May 22nd 2014 by Mr. Jan Mohammad Khan Jamali, Speaker Balochistan Assembly accompanied by Ms. Raheela Durrani (MPA). The Vice Chancellor, Registrar, senior administrative employees, Directors and Deans were present at the inauguration. The guests visited the medical center and met the medical center staff and appreciated the efforts of BUIEMS in extending medical facilities to staff and students.





Laboratory Facilities:

Free of cost minor tests such as Blood Glucose, Blood Group and HbsAg, are conducted within the medical center.

Emergency Services:

BUIITEMS medical center is equipped to provide initial emergency services to the students and employees and their families.

The staff provides first aid and dressing facilities and in case patients are referred to other hospitals, staff offers follow up in tertiary care. Ambulance remains standby in case of emergency referral cases.



Blood Donation Camp

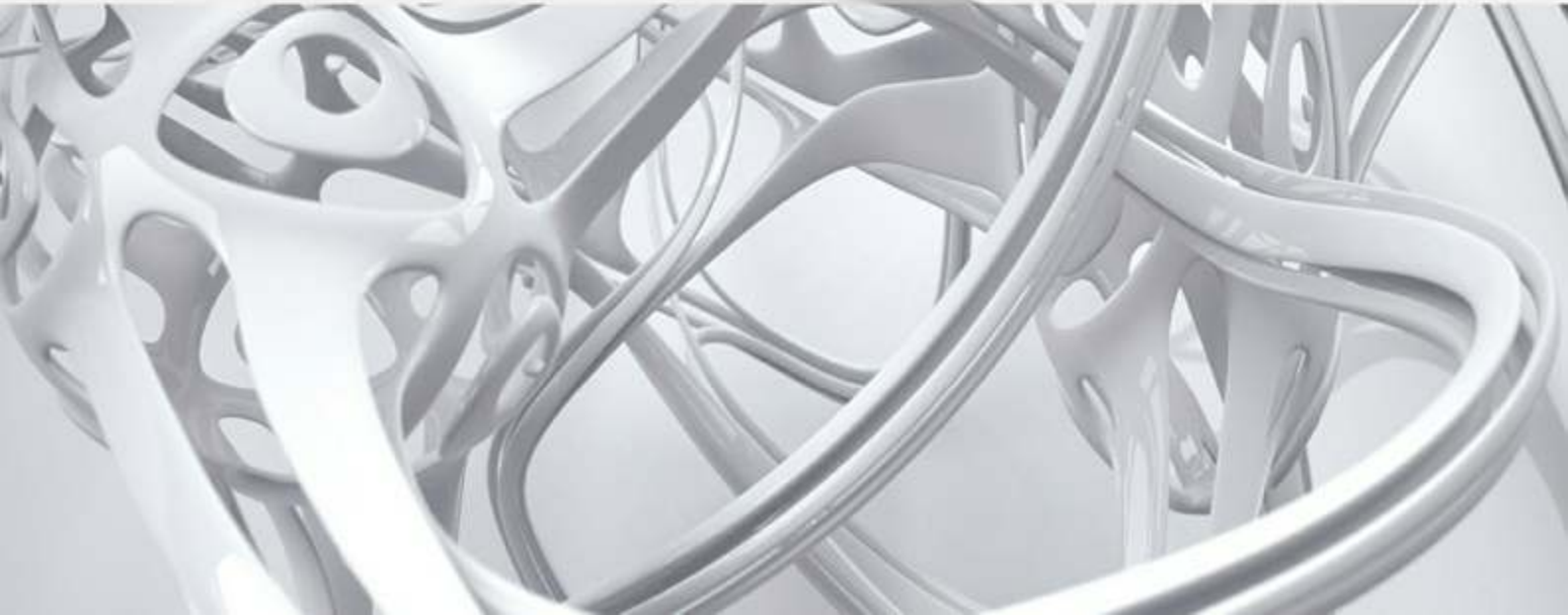

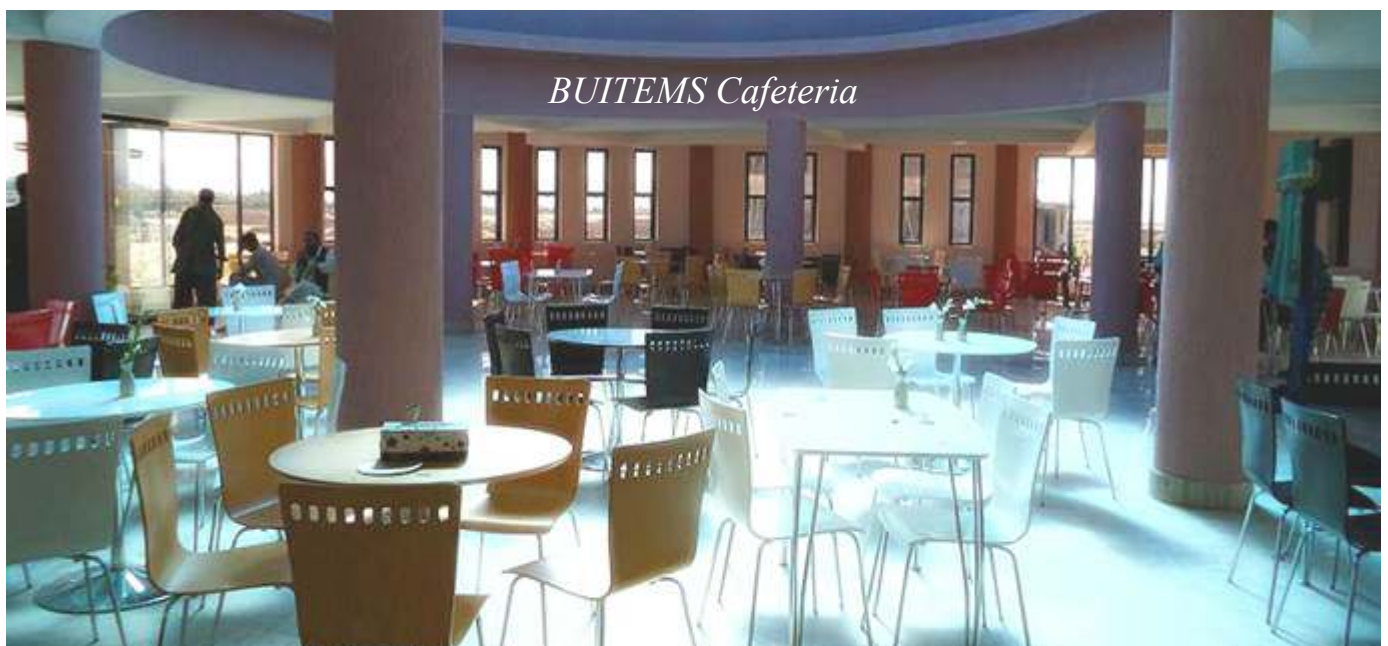

Commercial Cultivation of Mushrooms at Chiltan Campus

The Administrator Chiltan Campus Dr. Shawani initiated a project with the funding from the Office of Research Innovation & Commercialization (ORIC) Directorate of BUITEMS for the cultivation of mushrooms for commercialization.

Due to harsh and dry weather conditions in Quetta it was difficult to standardize the protocols for mushroom cultivation as mushroom growth requires 70% to 80% humidity and temperature of 15 to 25 degree Celsius. The consistent efforts and commitment of BUITEMS team made it possible to establish and standardize the protocols for cultivation of oyster mushrooms. Within a short period, the production from a laboratory to commercial scale was achieved. Within a year the oyster mushrooms produced at Chiltan Campus, were made available at commercial places in Quetta for sale. This project is now generating revenue and has set an example for the promotion of entrepreneurship.



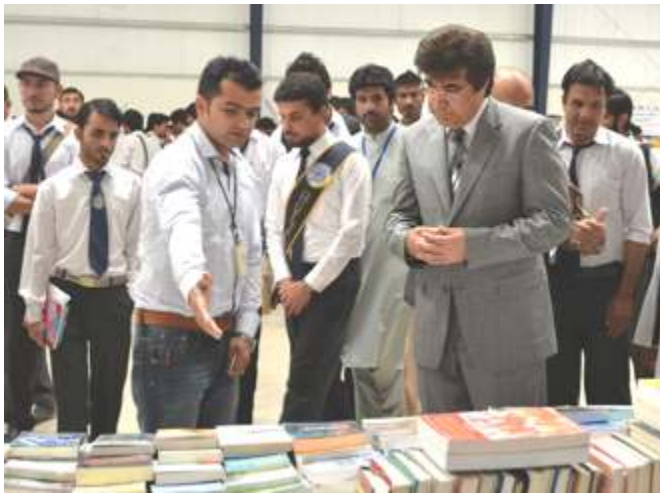
Information Session on U.S. Scholarships

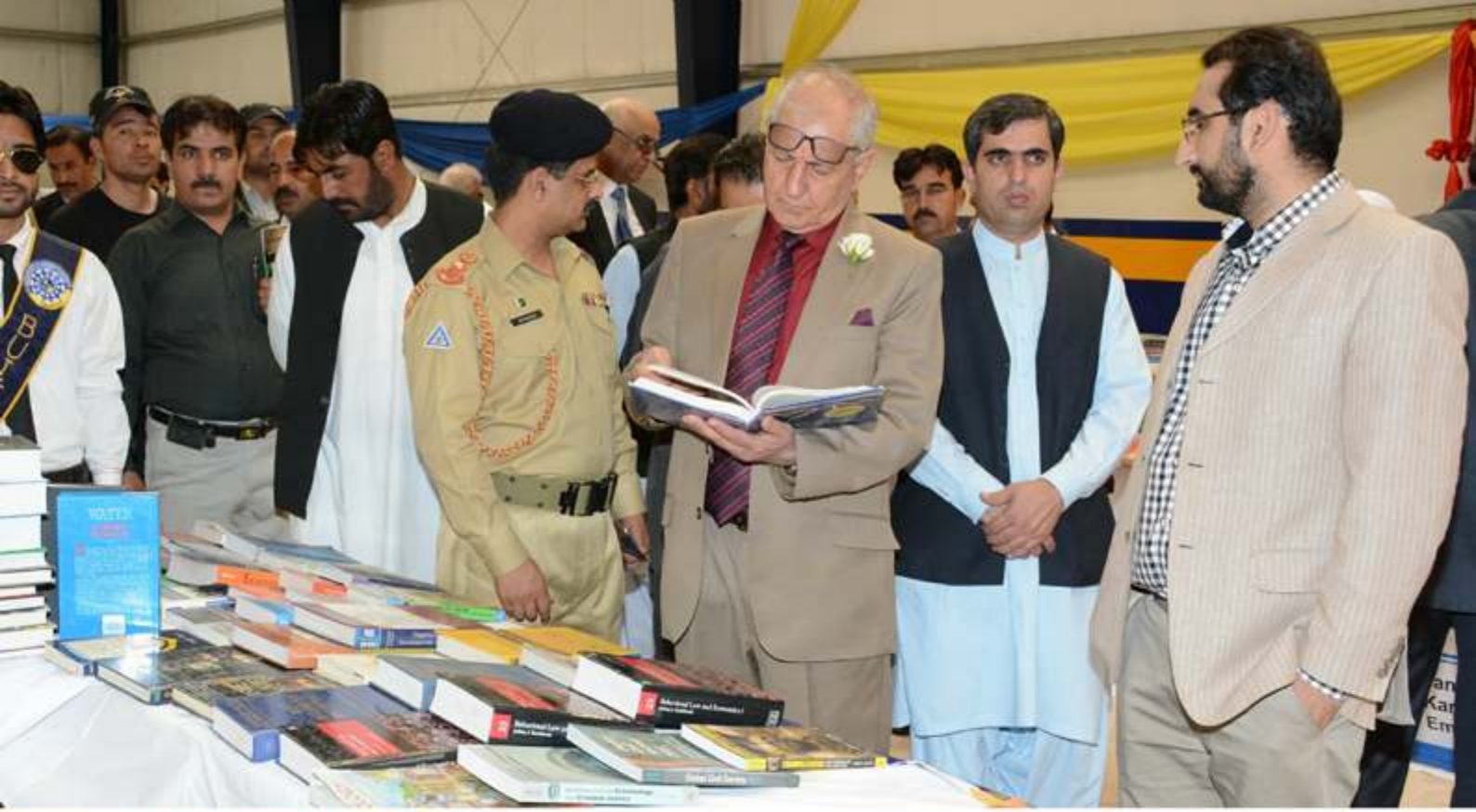
