China Study Center An Introduction

China Study Center (CSC) was established in 2021 at the Balochistan University of Information Technology, Engineering, and Management Sciences (BUITEMS) with the funds from the Higher Education Commission (HEC), Islamabad under PC-1 for "Academic Collaboration under the China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) Consortium of Universities". BUITEMS is a member of the CPEC Consortium of Universities which pledges to enhance cooperation in business, science, and technologies between Pakistan and China.

CSC has been mandated to promote academic, research, and cultural linkages among the Pakistani and Chinese universities. The Center deals with multidisciplinary research themes with a particular focus on CPEC. Besides, the CSC undertakes the teaching of the Chinese language and cultural domain to facilitate the capacity building of the people of Pakistan in general and Balochistan in particular.

To pool resources, CSC is placed under the functional and operational control of Balochistan Think Tank Network (BTTN), a sister think tank located within the premises of BUITEMS and raised by the National Command Authority (NCA), Islamabad.

Orientation Session for Chinese Language Course

He further enlightened students about how to learn Chinese as early as possible and introduced the syllabus of HSK-1. At the end of the session, Dr. Raja Asif Additional Director of CSC thanked all participants.

Chinese Language Classes at BUITEMS

The Classes for the Chinese language course (Hànyǔ shuǐpíng kǎoshì HSK-I) under China Study Center started on the 22nd of November 2021 at Takatu Campus, BUITEMS. HSK1 is a three-month basic introductory course on the Chinese

language. The classes were scheduled from 3:00 to 4:30 pm. Two sections A & B were formed and taught by Dr. Zamir Ahmed Abro and D r . R a j a A s i f Wagan, respectively.

A total of 36 students enrolled in the first batch out of which 26 completed the HSK-1 course. In the course, the students were taught Mandarin Chinese, in which, the reading, writing, and



speaking aspects of the language were covered. At the end of the session, a written exam was conducted on February 22, 2022.

Meeting with higher education commission on the progress of china study center

4th Exchange Mechanism Conference of China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) Consortium of Universities

Director of China Study Center, Dr. Abdul Sattar participated in the 4th Exchange Mechanism Conference of China Pakistan Economic (CPEC) Consortium of Universities Corridor via Zoom on 15 October 2021. The hybrid conference was held at Peking University China and the National University of Science Technology (NUST) Pakistan.

The conference was also attended by Pakistan's Minister of Federal Education and Professional Training, Shafqat Mehmood. From China, Du Yubo, President of the China Association of Higher Education, delivered a keynote speech on the friendship between China and Pakistan including diplomatic ties and education

collaborations. The meeting was attended by the representatives of

82 member universities of the CPEC Consortium of Universities from China and Pakistan. The conference also witnessed the establishment of the China-Pakistan Higher Education Research Institute to further facilitate high-end higher education research in various fields in both countries. The annual development report for 2019-2020 of the CPEC Consortium of Universities was also presented.

Chinese and Pakistani universities presented reports/studies on the promotion of quality development of higher education cooperation and post-pandemic opportunities and challenges faced by both countries.
